



Poland Swim and Tennis Club - Standing Club Rules

THESE RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE BY ACTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES. THE POOL MANAGER AND THE GUARDS HAVE COMPLETE AUTHORITY TO ENFORCE THE RULES, INCLUDING SUSPENSION FROM ALL PRIVILEGES FOR OFFENDERS.

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

1. The Operating Season will be from the weekend of Memorial Day until Labor Day, unless extended by the Board.
2. Operating hours are 12:00pm to 9:00pm in June/July and 11pm to 8pm in August. However, while school is in session, operating hours are 4:00pm to 8:00pm Monday to Thursday and 4:00 pm- 9:00 pm Friday to Sunday. If the air temperature is less than 70 degrees the manager has the authority to close the pool. The manager may close the pool at any time for safety reasons.
3. Each person entering the facility must check in with their membership number at the front desk.
4. If members' children are coming to the facility with another member, you should still check in with your own membership number.
5. No smoking or vaping is permitted inside the enclosure.
6. No pets of any kind are permitted inside the enclosure.
7. Lost items will be turned into the office. Valuable items such as watches, rings, wallets and keys will be held by the manager until claimed. Common items such as toys, towels and caps will be disposed of by the Manager or the Board periodically.
8. The Club cannot and will not accept responsibility for personal property and valuables. Efforts will be made to recover lost articles, but members are urged to leave their valuables at home and to label their personal property being used at the Club.
9. Glassware of any kind is not to be brought into the Swim Club unless authorized by the Board of Trustees.
10. No food, snacks, candy or beverages are allowed in the main pool or baby pool, on the pool deck, in the restrooms, on the tennis, basketball or bocce courts and the gaga pit. Members and guests are reminded to clean their area and place all trash in the trash receptacles.
11. Trash containers will be properly placed and their use is requested. All chairs, lounge chairs and lowboys are Club property and must not be abused.

12. Safety regulations are defined and enforced by the Manager. They are posted, along with other information of interest in the office. Members are requested to check the bulletin board daily.
13. No rough or boisterous play, running or objectionable language will be tolerated.
14. Bicycles must be parked in the bike rack provided. Bicycles, motorbikes, etc. are not to be used on Club property for recreational purposes.
15. Please refrain from sitting, leaning, climbing or resting your feet on the fences.
16. Parties must be paid in full to reserve a spot and cancellations must be made 24 hours in advance. Parties may be held in the snack, tennis or pump house pavilions. All reservations must be approved by management and reservation forms must be placed on file in the office. Parties may take place in June and July from 1pm- 4pm or 5pm- 8pm. In August parties can be held from 12pm-3pm or 4pm-7pm. The rental fee for a pavilion for club members is \$200 and \$500 for non-members (M-Th evening parties only).

GUEST POLICIES

1. The charge for guests to use the pool and/or tennis facilities will be \$10.00 per day, per guest when paying at the door or a discounted rate is available when purchasing online in your Member Splash account (processing fee is charged). The charge for guests entering the pool after 6:00pm is \$5.00.
2. Local guests within 50 miles of Poland are limited to six (6) visits per season. Guests residing more than 50 miles outside of Poland are not limited in the amount of visits per season.
3. Local grandchildren of members are limited to 14 visits per season.
4. In order to have a guest signed in under your membership, you **MUST** be present at the pool. Guests will not be admitted to the pool unless the member signing them in is present and staying at the facility with the guest.
5. Grandparents and In-Laws acting as baby-sitters in the absence of parents will be admitted at no charge.
6. All guests must be registered by members. Guests' names will be written down on members' cards in the office. All rules of the Club apply also to the guest.
7. The sponsoring member shall be responsible for the conduct of their guest.
8. Daily guest privileges will be in effect until the close of the Club facility that day.
9. Guests shall be entitled to a "rain check" if they are registered less than two hours and the Club is closed. "Rain checks" will not be issued to guests registering after 7:00pm.
10. **BABY-SITTERS** responsible for members' children (12 yrs. old & younger) in the absence of parents due to their working, illness or extenuating circumstances may be admitted at no charge.

HOUSE GUESTS

1. Members having out-of-town house guests for a period of one week or longer may register these guests in advance of their use of the Club facility with the Club Manager and then purchase weekly passes \$20.00 for individuals or \$40.00 for families or 4 or more.
2. Exchange Student guests living with a host family shall be considered as part of that family but must register each time they enter the facility.

POOL REGULATIONS

1. Children 11 years of age and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times. For this rule, an adult is a person 15 years old or older.
2. Members should not request the staff to assume custody of their children.
3. Conversation with pool personnel on duty should be kept to a minimum.
4. Members will observe prudence in the matter of poison ivy and other communicable diseases. If you or your children have such, do not enter the water. If there is any question, the Manager is authorized to request a certification of health from a doctor.
5. Members of any age who cannot swim should not go near the diving area.
6. Children who cannot stand in the shallow end of the pool with their heads above the water will not be permitted in the main pool unless accompanied by an adult.
7. Inflatable toys are permitted only in the wading pool. The use of balls, fins, masks and snorkels will be permitted in the main pool only at the discretion of the Manager. Every Sunday from 5:00pm to 9:00pm is designated as "Float Night". Members may use inflatable devices during this time on the lane side of the pool.
8. The use of the wading pool is restricted to children unable to use the main pool. The safety of those children using the wading pool is the responsibility of the accompanying adult. **AT NO TIME ARE CHILDREN OLD ENOUGH TO USE THE MAIN POOL PERMITTED TO ENTER THE WADING POOL.**
9. Pool ladders are to be used only for entering and leaving the water. Do not block them for any other purpose.
10. Chewing gum is not permitted in the pool.
11. Proper bathing attire must be worn at all times. Cutoffs, gym trunks, etc. are not considered proper bathing attire.
12. The pool check and Adult Swim (if announced) will take place each hour.
13. Adults (18 years old and older) are permitted to use designated lanes to swim laps from 10:00 am until the pool opens.

TENNIS/PICKLEBALL COURT ETIQUETTE

1. When entering or leaving the courts, do not walk behind players when a point is in play. Wait until the point is completed or the players signal you to cross the court.
2. If your ball goes on another court, let the other players retrieve it for **you**. NEVER go after a ball in another court and NEVER INTERRUPT the play of others to call for an unnoticed ball in their court.
3. Always throw the metal tops of tennis ball cans in the trash baskets.
4. Shoes should be worn on tennis courts at all times.
5. Tennis and Pickleball racks are available for checkout at the front desk and should be returned at the end of usage.
6. These are your tennis courts. Time and money are needed to maintain them. Let's keep them looking great by obeying the rules.

TENNIS REGULATIONS - OFF SEASON

1. A gate key will be required for the northwest gate entrance. A key may be obtained at the Club office for a nominal cost. New keys are \$10 and replacement keys are available for a reissue fee.
2. Since reservations are not necessary, play will begin and end on the hour and will be limited to one hour unless no one is waiting. This means that people waiting for courts will be entitled to the court on the hour, regardless of whether the preceding players have only been playing for 15 minutes, a half hour, etc.
3. There will be no charge for daylight play. For night play, lights are provided by a timer/meter where lights are installed. Please remember that play begins and ends on the hour, regardless of when you begin or how much time you have remaining on the meter.
4. As a courtesy to our neighbors, night play ceases at 11:00pm.
5. When play is completed be sure that you **TURN OFF THE LIGHTS** and **LOCK THE GATE**.
6. Adults 18 years and older have preference for courts, starting at 6:00 pm on weekdays and at 1:00pm on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. However, play may not be interrupted once started.
7. All general rules as stated in the previous section apply in addition to the above rules for off-season play. Simply disregard any portion pertaining to reserved courts.
8. These rules are enforced by PSC managers and board members at all times.
