**ENFORCEMENT OF CLUB RULES IS EVERY
MEMBER'S RESPONSIBILITY**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Dear Member:

The following is an excerpt from the By-laws of the Pearl River-Nauraushaun Swim Club and rules and regulations for the protection and benefit of all members. These rules and regulations have been established not only to assure safe and sanitary operation of the pool and facilities but also to assure a place of great enjoyment for you. Parents are requested to acquaint their children with these rules and to caution them to observe all rules and obey instructions of the pool managers and other employees. Any failure to comply with these rules shall be considered sufficient cause for immediate suspension of pool privileges for the offending member. Failure to comply may also be considered sufficient cause for cancellation of membership.

I.

ADMISSION OF MEMBERS

a. Only a person who is at least twenty-one (21) years of age, a resident of the Town of Orangetown, and surrounding areas with member-sponsor. Whose membership is not detrimental to the welfare and aims of the Club, may be admitted to membership.

b. The Club shall have a regular (family) membership, an Adults-Only Membership, a Senior Membership, an Adult-Single Membership, and an *Associate Membership. The regular membership may only be issued to the head of the household. A household shall be defined as a family permanently living together, consisting of head of household, spouse, all unmarried children who have not reached their twenty-first (21st) birthday by July 1 of the current year, and all adult dependents living in the household who are not self-supporting because of a permanent disability.

c. *Associate memberships shall consist of all members of a family living together over the age of twenty-one (21), also a mother, father, or mother-in-law or father-in-law not gainfully employed, living permanently with a regular member. The fee for associate membership is \$100 per person. Applications are available at www.PearlRiverSwimClub.com.

d. Regular members who have been members of the Club (or has been a spouse of a member of the Club) for a total of 5 years, shall be eligible to elect adults-only membership. If interested, information regarding adults-only membership is available at www.PearlRiverSwimClub.com. Adults only

membership is limited to 100 members.

e. Regular members or adults only members over 60 years of age with 20 years of Club membership may apply for senior membership. If interested, information regarding senior membership is available at www.PearlRiverSwimClub.com. Senior membership is limited to 95 members.

II.

CLUB HOURS

a. Weekdays, Saturdays, and Holidays --10:00 AM to 8:30 PM. Sundays --11:00 AM to 8:30 PM. NOTE: Pool closes at **8:00 PM**. Grounds must be vacated by **8:30 PM**.

b. Areas of the pool may be reserved for group or individual swim instruction, said areas to be marked by means of rope and floats.

c. The pool may be closed for maintenance operations, health conditions, weather, or any other reason deemed appropriate by the Pool Manager.

d. The pool schedule is posted on the Club's website at www.PearlRiverSwimClub.com.

e. The manager in conjunction with the Board of Directors Social Committee may designate special nights for adult or teenage swims. Special events for this year are posted on the Club's website at www.PearlRiverSwimClub.com.

III.

GENERAL ADMISSION TO CLUB AREA

a. Regular guests: A guest privilege shall consist of admission to the pool for one individual for the entire day. No guests will be admitted on Labor Day. The Club's Board of Directors, at its discretion, may limit the maximum number of guests permitted during a season.

b. Special Guests: Babysitters (MEMBER ASSUMES RESPONSIBILITY) are permitted only in place of parents. Babysitters must be at least 15 years of age, attested to in writing by the head of the household. A Babysitter pass for the season may be purchased for \$100 at the Club office. A one-day babysitter guest pass (if accompanied by a letter from the member (head of household)) is

available at the regular guest rate.

c. Guests may enter only with the sponsoring member and the conduct of the guests is the direct responsibility of the sponsoring member. Any member bringing in ten (10) or more guests on any one date must provide a list identifying each individual guest by name and age.

d. Members are prohibited from using the Club premises for personal gain, such as Day Care, or any other business activity.

e. Guest Rates:

Weekdays -- \$10.00 ea. adult 18 years and older; \$9.00 ea. child 2 through 17 years.

After 4 PM weekdays - \$8.00 ea. adult 18 years and older; \$7.00 ea. child 2 years through 17 years.

Weekends and most Holidays -- \$15.00 ea. adult 18 years and older; \$13.00 ea. child 2 years through 17 years.

July 4th - \$25.00 adults and children

e. NO MONEY WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE POOL OFFICE. Members having guests will be billed throughout the swimming season. Credit cards are also excepted.

IV.

RULES GOVERNING ADMISSION OF CHILDREN TO CLUB AND POOL AREA

a. In determining age, the age of the child as of September 15 of each year shall be the controlling date.

b. ADMISSION OF CHILDREN UNDER 10 YEARS OF AGE TO CLUB AND POOL AREA: Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult member of the household or a responsible household member 15 years of age or over. QUALIFIED SWIMMERS under 10 years of age may enter pool unaccompanied provided parents are in the club area. NON-SWIMMERS 4 through 10 years of age may use the main pool but must be accompanied by a household adult or a responsible household member. Children under 4 years of age will not be permitted in the main pool.

c. ADMISSION OF CHILDREN OVER 10 YEARS OF AGE TO CLUB AND POOL AREA: QUALIFIED SWIMMERS between the ages of 10 and 12 who have passed the basic swimming tests under the supervision of a pool manager and/or his assistants may be admitted to the pool unaccompanied by an adult. NON-SWIMMERS are not allowed in the deep section of the pool until they have passed basic swimming tests.

d. No family members under the age of 13 may bring guests. Guests of family members between 13 and 15 must be at least 13 years old.

e. ADMISSION OF CHILDREN TO CLUB AREA AFTER 6 PM: All children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult member of the household after 6 PM.

f. SPECIAL RULES: Adult Swim - For a 30 minute period at 1PM and 3PM Weekdays, and at 2PM and 4PM Weekends; the main pool is cleared of children for the purpose of allowing only adults to use the pool. This schedule may be altered at the discretion of the manager on duty.

The Kiddie Pool will be limited to children under 8 years of age. No metal or rigid plastic toys will be allowed in the Kiddie Pool. Children must be supervised by an adult other than the Lifeguard.

The Slide is open all day. The Slide may be used by children 4 years of age and older but children under 48 inches and height must be supervised by an adult that is not a swim club staff member while using the slide.

Toys including but not limited to; kickboards, diving sticks, inflatables, balls, etc. are prohibited in main pool unless otherwise noted. Toys are allowed in the kiddie pool.

g. SWIMMING INSTRUCTIONS: Swimming and diving instructions and water safety programs will be conducted by pool personnel. Schedules will be posted for these activities. During instruction periods, sections of the pool will be restricted for this use. Other water activities will be considered as time and progress permits.

V.

MEMBER OBLIGATIONS AND CONDUCT

a. Membership numbers are issued to each individual adult member and child that is a Qualified Swimmer. This means the child has passed the swim test administered to children 10 years of age and older. This permits the child to come to the pool unaccompanied by an adult and is NOT TRANSFERABLE.

b. Misuse of membership will result in immediate expulsion from Club grounds of the unauthorized person(s) and suspension and possible expulsion from the Club for the entire household membership.

c. VEHICLES must be driven slowly and carefully on access roads and in the parking lot. Excessive speeds and any other form of annoyance to our neighbors must be avoided.

d. All bicycle riders will use the bicycle stall and ride carefully. They must keep off private property and must respect the property of our neighbors.

e. Cost of any property damage by members or guests will be charged to the responsible member; willful damage of Club property will result in suspension of membership.

f. Members are encouraged to limit consumption of food and refreshments to the Picnic Areas. Members and guests are expected to clean up after themselves and deposit trash, recyclables, etc. in the appropriate bins. Food and drink are not permitted on the pool deck or in the pool at any time.

g. Chairs, lounges and/or tables cannot be reserved by or for members or guests who are not on the Club premises. Such club property is restricted for use by adults (over 18 years of age) on weekends and/or crowded days.

h. Private chairs are not permitted on club grounds except for Memorial Day, July 4th, and Labor Day. Chairs may not be placed on the pool deck or concrete walks.

i. No abusive language will be permitted.

j. The Managers at their discretion may order people off the Club premises for any violation or infraction of the By-laws or the Rules and Regulations.

VI.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

a. All bathers must shower before entering the pool. A shower must be taken to remove suntan oil before entering the pool. Street shoes are not allowed on the paved pool area. Cut off pants are not considered bathing suits and are not permitted to be worn in the pool.

b. Smoking/vaping of any kind is prohibited within pool grounds. All smoking can be done out in the parking lot at designated areas. All smoking material must be

deposited in receptacles provided in designated smoking areas.

c. Admission to the pool shall be refused to anyone with colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infection or wearing bandages. Sanitary habits must be observed.

d. No pets allowed on the club property.

e. No glass containers of any kind are allowed on the Club property.

f. No food or drinks in pool or on pool decks

g. No running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing, or causing undue disturbance in or about the pool area (this includes the areas around chairs). Running and sports activities should be relegated to the extremities of the property (i.e. basketball & wiffle ball field)

h. One of the prime purposes of our club is to teach non-swimmers to swim. Kapok or cork jackets, or air-filled tubes will not be permitted in the pool, nor will underwater masks, flippers, snorkels, etc. be permitted.

i. Expectorating and nose blowing in the pool is prohibited.

j. Diving will be permitted only in designated areas.

VII.

USE OF CLUB FACILITIES

a. Bathhouse: Personal belongings must be recovered from the bathhouse and grounds at the end of each day. Members reserving lockers must abide by the rules provided within the Locker Reservation Policy. Bathhouse cleanliness issues and/or out of order conditions should be reported to a Pool Manager immediately when observed.

b. Picnic Area: The picnic area will be available to members and their guests. Picnic tables must be relinquished and cleared upon completion of a meal. Picnic tables cannot be reserved or claimed in advance of a contemplated meal. Clean area and table after use.

c. Cooking Facilities: The Club will provide an adequate number of grills in the Picnic area.

NOTE: NO FLAMMABLE FLUID WILL BE PERMITTED ON CLUB PREMISES. THEREFORE, YOU MUST USE YOUR OWN SUPPLY OF PRESOAKED BRIQUETTES.

d. Playground Facilities: Parents or responsible adults must supervise their children in the playground area.

e. General Area: Play pens, baby carriages, car seats, beds, strollers are permitted, but must not be on walks, decks, or within 15 feet of either pool. All items must be removed from the club grounds by the close of each day.

VIII.

GENERAL RULES

a. All persons using any of the Club facilities do so at their own risk. The club will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with such use.

b. The Club will not be responsible for loss or damage to personal property. No personal property will be accepted for safekeeping.

d. All suggestions or complaints must be made in writing, signed, and emailed to the Board of Directors at info@pearliverswimclub.com or left at the Club office.

e. Guest privileges may be restricted at any time in the best interest of the Club.

f. These rules and regulations may be revised at any time by the Board of Directors. Notice of any changes or additions will be posted on the Club bulletin board and on the Club's website at www.PearlRiverSwimClub.com.
