The Board voted to pass the motion to incur the \$8,375 BYOB liability policy coverage for the 2026 season. We hope our members continue to enjoy our facilities responsibly and safely!

Facilities Updates

Reminder to ALL

We ALL have a responsibility to one another to keep Peachwood a safe, clean, and welcoming club. This means we ALL take care of our facilities, furniture, games, and grounds.

- Chairs are meant for sitting - not standing on or using as backstops or bases
- Tables are meant to sit at - not sit or climb ON
- Using the grills or eating at a table? Please wipe down after you are done & throw away your trash.
- Keep the pool deck tidy & close umbrellas if leaving for the day

Damaged Property Policy Reminder

Important reminder: Break it -> Buy it

The 2023 & 2024 seasons saw an increase in damaged property and equipment that required replacement at the Club's expense. Per the [Club's By-Law](#) Article 10, Section 6 and Rules Section 2, # 9 - broken/damaged property by member or guest, shall be promptly paid for by said member.

Past examples include:

- Standing on children's Splash Pool gate
- Hanging or pulling on the lane lines
- Umbrellas being open/closed while wedged against a fixed object resulting in damage or torn canopies



This policy will be enforced for 2026 and members will be held accountable for replacement/repair of damaged Club property.
