Annual Membership Meeting

Peachwood will hold its Annual Membership Meeting at the pool on **Monday, September 21st**. All members are welcome to join to hear from our Board Officers of the 2026 Season highlights and proposed initiatives going into the 2027 Season.

We have (4) openings on our Board beginning with the 2026-2027 Season. All positions are for a term of (3) years. The following positions are open for election this cycle:

- Secretary (Officer)
- Treasurer (Officer)
- Membership Co-Coordinator (Officer)
- General Board Member

The meeting agenda will also include the Club's finance report with a review of the 2026 and 2027 budgets. All bonded Peachwood members will have an opportunity to cast their votes (1 per family) for 48 hours after the meeting closes (9/23). We will notify all participants of the results first, and share results with the member community via email after.

We will also bring for discussion and vote on a "pool improvement" referendum which would cover the expenses to install a 3-lane, 25-meter lap pool. A project of this magnitude would require the Club to take out a loan of up to \$275,000 to cover the installation and pump/filter requirements.

Our 1st-4th graders had the Club to themselves as they enjoyed an afternoon of dancing, pizza, snacks, games and general FUN. Reminder to ALL

Damaged Property Policy Reminder

Important reminder: Break it -> Buy it

The 2024& 2025 seasons saw an increase in damaged property and equipment that required replacement at the Club's expense. Per the [Club's By-Law](#) Article 10, Section 6 and Rules Section 2, # 9 - broken/damaged property by member or guest, shall be promptly paid for by said member.

Past examples include:

- Standing on children's Splash Pool gate
- Hanging or pulling on the lane lines
- Umbrellas being open/closed while wedged against a fixed object resulting in damage or torn canopies

This policy will be enforced for 2026 and members will be held accountable for replacement/repair of damaged Club property.
