Pool Rules & Regulations

Welcome to the Pool at Hollingsworth Park! We kindly request that all visitors contribute positively to the community atmosphere by enjoying the pool facilities responsibly and safely, helping to maintain a clean and welcoming environment, respecting others and following these rules and regulations:

RESPONSIBILITY

1. All visitors use the pool facilities at their own risk.
2. We expect responsible behavior by all visitors to the pool facilities. Any person, whether member or guest who, in the sole discretion of lifeguards and pool staff, exhibits behavior in or around the pool that is dangerous, reckless and/or disruptive to other members or guests, may be required to leave the pool premises immediately.
3. The cost of property damage caused by the willful misconduct or gross negligence of any member or guest may be charged to the responsible member or accompanying member of the guest responsible for the damage.

ADMISSION

1. All members and guests must check in and be admitted by a staff member before entering the pool premises. All members must be properly registered on Member Splash with paid account status. Pool staff on duty have the discretion and authority to refuse admission to any visitor who is not a valid member or guest of a member.
2. Maximum capacity of the pool is established by DHEC regulations. Pool staff on duty have the discretion and authority to limit admission to the pool premises when maximum capacity is reached.

3. No child under 10 years old, whether member or guest and regardless of swimming ability, shall be admitted to the pool without an accompanying parent or responsible guardian who is (i) at least 16 years old and (ii) a member or registered guest of a member.

GUESTS

1. Use of the pool is reserved for members and guests who are accompanied by a member and admitted with a valid guest pass. Each guest must check in and be properly admitted by a staff member. No member may admit a guest without properly checking in. Any member who enables a visitor to enter the pool without properly checking in may be required to leave the pool immediately and may have membership suspended or revoked.
2. No more than 6 guests per member account will be admitted to the pool at any one time. Groups with more than 6 guests per member account require event rental by prior arrangement and subject to approval by pool staff.
3. All guest passes are prepaid and must be purchased by members in advance on Member Splash. Guest passes are valid for a single visit to the pool.
4. Members are responsible for advising their visiting guests of pool rules and regulations, and guests are responsible to abide by the pool rules and regulations while visiting the pool.

SAFETY

1. No one under the age of 19 may use the pool unless a lifeguard is on duty. Lifeguards will clear the pool of everyone under the age of 19 once per hour for a period of 10 minutes. During this period, pool staff and lifeguards will not be on duty, nor will they be responsible for anyone using the pool.
2. During summer opening hours, certified pool staff and lifeguards are provided to oversee the pool facility. Staff are trained in first aid and CPR, and first aid kits and emergency equipment are available in the pool house.

Any visitor who requires assistance in case of an injury or medical incident should communicate with a pool staff member or lifeguard on duty.

3. Pool staff and lifeguards may, at their discretion, temporarily close the pool facilities due to required maintenance, adverse weather or other unforeseen circumstances. The pool must be evacuated when lightning is detected in the area. In the event of temporary pool closure, visitors will be notified about the closure and informed of the expected reopening time.
4. Playing with or tampering with any pool equipment or safety equipment, including depth marker rope and floats, is not allowed.
5. Floats, tubes, rafts, balls and other pool toys may not be unreasonably large nor interfere with the safety and enjoyment of other visitors. Pool staff and lifeguards may, in their sole discretion, prohibit any such items in the pool.
6. Diving from the pool deck is allowed in the deep end only. No flips—whether front or backflips—are allowed from the pool deck. Playing on or jumping from the swim starting blocks is not allowed. Improvised slides and diving boards are not allowed.
7. No motorized toys or devices that may pose a safety hazard to pool users—such as those with exposed propellers, high-speed motors, or underwater propulsion capabilities (e.g., diving scooters)—are allowed in the pool.
8. No running, pushing, wrestling, towel snapping or unreasonably rough play is allowed on the pool premises.
9. All furniture must remain at least four feet away from the edge of the pool.
10. No bicycles, scooters, skateboards or other riding toys are allowed in the pool facilities.

HEALTH & ENJOYMENT

1. All visitors must shower before entering the pool as required by South Carolina DHEC. Showers and foot wash stations are available in the provided restrooms and on the periphery of the pool facilities.

2. No visitor may enter the pool with a communicable disease; skin, eye, ear, or nasal disorder; open sore; or other infection.
3. Appropriate and clean swim attire is required in the pool.
4. Children who are not toilet trained are required to wear an appropriate and properly fitted swim diaper. Clothing and diapers should be changed within the provided restrooms. Pool decontamination requires a chemical treatment and mandatory closure of minimum 2 hours and up to 24 hours and costs the pool hundreds of dollars per occurrence. The cost of pool decontamination resulting from negligence or failure to wear a swim diaper may be charged to the responsible member.
5. No spitting or nose-blowing is allowed in the pool.
6. No smoking or use of tobacco products is allowed on the pool premises.
7. No pets or animals are allowed in the pool facilities.
8. All members and guests are responsible to dispose of their own trash in the provided trash containers.
9. No loud or offensive music that interferes with the enjoyment of other visitors is allowed.

FOOD & BEVERAGES

1. Members and guests are permitted to bring outside food and beverages for personal consumption within designated areas of the pool facilities. No food or beverages may be consumed within any part of the pool. No glass containers are allowed anywhere on the pool premises.
2. Public intoxication is prohibited. Visitors found to be visibly intoxicated or causing disruption to the enjoyment of other visitors due to intoxication will be asked to leave the pool immediately. We expect responsible behavior by everyone enjoying the pool facility.

SWIM LESSONS

1. No swim lessons may be conducted at the Pool except by prior arrangement with Upstate Pool Management. Please contact recruiting@upstatepoolmanagement.com to arrange all swim lessons.

AUTHORITY

1. Pool staff and lifeguards have full authority to enforce all pool rules and regulations and may restrict or deny use of the pool to anyone who refuses to comply with their reasonable and appropriate instructions.
2. In accordance with Article 13 of the Bylaws of the Chadsworth Drive Swim Club, Inc., the Board of Directors may suspend or revoke access to the pool to anyone who violates the bylaws or rules and regulations of the pool.
